## ORDINANCE NUMBER 1 - 1976

An Ordinance restricting the weight of vehicles using certain highways within the Township of White, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

The supervisors of White Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. In order to limit the deterioration and serious damage to highways within the Township by reason of excessive weight, the operation of vehicles, the gross weight of which is ten (10) tons or more, said weight to be the gross weight of the vehicle and its load when operated on Township roads TR# 503, TR# 504, TR# 505, TR# 509, TR# 512, TR# 561, and TR# 569 is hereby prohibited.

Section 2. The Township Supervisors shall cause to have erected official signs indicating the limitation of weight on said highways at each end of that highway and any intersection of said highway and the within Ordinance shall not be effective until such official signs are erected.

Section 3. Any person refusing to unload his excessive load when ordered by a peace officer in uniform or by violating any provision of Section 1 shall upon summary of conviction before a magistrate be sentenced to a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five (5) days:

PROVIDED, however, that this penalty shall not apply to the operation of farm tractors.

Section 4. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Act of Assembly approved the 29th day of April, 1959, P.L. 58; Section 1101.
