

James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther , Fred Soisson, and Tracy Plessinger; Chest Township supervisors Mark Lechene and Don Holtz; Dave Cunningham of Keller Engineers; and Rick Gates. Bob Barnhart, Bill Barnhart, and Chest Township supervisor Kathy McCusker arrived at 7:12.

The minutes of the March regular meeting were read. Fred Soisson made a motion to approve the minutes. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

#### Visitors

Dave Cunningham, of Keller Engineers reported that the funding application for our sewage and water projects is proceeding as planned. The first phase of our plan should be funded no later than this fall and the second phase in the following budget year.

Bob Barnhart and Bill Barnhart were not present when the meeting began. Their concerns were discussed under New Business/Secretaries Report.

#### Public/Supervisor Comment

None.

#### Old Business

We have received a letter from Attorney Govachini agreeing to our request that we not be billed for writing opinions that we did not request.

We have received two letters from Kathy Barquist. One informed us that she would work through April 26 to get the taxes that are due on the 15<sup>th</sup>. The other informed us that she has received the money due from Bradford Township, Clearfield County and it has been disbursed to the appropriate parties.

#### New Business/Secretaries Report

The secretary presented the minutes from the March meeting and agenda from April meeting of CCSEA.

There was a discussion concerning the need for an intermunicipal agreement to participate in the CCBCEA. Fred Soisson made a motion to approve the intermunicipal agreement as presented to participate in the CCBCEA. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

There was a discussion concerning the need for ordinances to opt in to the UCC enforcement and to become a part of the CCBCEA. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to instruct the solicitor to prepare and advertise the above ordinances. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

We have received a letter from the county regarding the county-wide GIS program and requesting that we participate financially. Fred Soisson is the township's representative to the GIS board and gave a report on the value and progress of the program. The county is requesting that we provide \$573.77 a year for three years for a total of \$1,721.31 toward the GIS program. Fred Soisson made a motion to pay \$573.77 immediately to the County GIS program and to budget the additional funds in each of the next two years. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The supervisors have interviewed four applicants of the position of township EIT/OPT collector. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to hire Lisa Helbig of Patton as our EIT/OPT collector at a commission of 5% of collections. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

We have received 12 building permit applications for new construction along Swartz Road that would utilize the Glendale Yearound Sewage Treatment Plant. The secretary is hesitant to issue the permits because the township has approved no planning for a needed expansion of the treatment plant. Also, the plant's NPDES permit expired on March 9, 2003 and we have received no notification from DEP as to the current status of the permit application. It is also unclear if the lots in question along Swartz Road were a part of the Glendale Yearound Sewage Treatment Plant's service area in the original planning module. There was concern expressed by the supervisors that the township could be liable for any damage that would occur by issuing permits that put the plant over its permitted capacity. More information from all parties involved will be needed before decisions can be made about the issuing of building permits that will increase the flow of sewage to the Glendale Yearound Treatment Plant. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to rescind, effective immediately, the appointment of the president of the Glendale Corporation, or his designee, as a building permit issuing agent for White Township for any construction that could potentially increase the flow of sewage to the Glendale Yearound Sewage Treatment Plant. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye. The secretary will notify the Glendale Corporation of our decision. The secretary will also contact DEP officials, and the township's solicitor and engineer to determine the proper course of action concerning building permits that would increase the flow of sewage to the Glendale Yearound Sewage Plant.

A motion was made by Tracy Plessinger to apply for county highway aid in the amount of \$12,000. Fred Soisson seconded the motion a vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The secretary reported that the Annual Spring Convention of the CCATO will be held at the Lemon Drop Lounge on Friday, April 30. Reservations are due by Friday, April 23.

The secretary reminded the supervisors that State Ethics Forms must be returned by May 1.

The secretary reported on various training opportunities for elected and appointed officials.

Payment of Accounts

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to pay the following bills and to authorize the secretary to pay any additional bills necessary to make all accounts current for the end of the year. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.
