James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther, Neal Maneval, and Tracy Plessinger, Charlie Lockey, Bill Davis, and Tom Dedea

The minutes of the March regular meeting were read. Neal Maneval made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Visitors

None.

Public/Supervisor Comment

Charlie Lockey asked about the possibility of a junk car or junk yard ordinance. The supervisors explained that they intend to be very cautious about implementing such an ordinance. There are several legal problems involved including the definition of a "public nuisance". The secretary reported that in his discussions with other rural townships in our area he has found that there have been problems with trying to enforce such ordinances. The secretary will continue to seek information from other area townships but at present no action was proposed.

Bill Davis asked whether the supervisors have considered the possibility of implementing zoning in anticipation of the municipal water and sewer systems. A brief discussion followed regarding the pros and cons of zoning and sub division ordinances. No action was proposed at this time.

Old Business

Central Tax Bureau is continuing to review past year's tax receipts to determine the proper distribution of the money on deposit in the former EIT collectors account.

The solicitor has reviewed a resolution regarding the Glendale Yearound Sewer and Water Systems. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the resolution. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The secretary reminded the supervisors that the Spring Convention of the Cambria County Association of Township Officials will be held on Friday, May 5. Reservations must be submitted one week prior to that date.

All supervisors have completed IS100 and IS700 NIMS training.

A possible summer road project was discussed. The road master reported that Bob Mills, PennDOT Municipal Services Representative, recommended that no township roads are in need of paving this year. Also, the secretary reported that there is currently a question as to whether road maintenance projects must be bid at prevailing wages. If prevailing wages are required for road maintenance bids it will greatly increase the cost of this work. After discussion it was determined that no major road project would be scheduled for this summer. The secretary will contact the county and request that our county aid liquid fuels funds be encumbered for a future project.

New Business/Secretaries Report

We have had several calls from Glendale Yearound residents requesting "reverse subdivision" for their properties. These calls have been generated by a letter that was sent by the Glendale Water and Sewer Companies to Yearound residents who own more than one lot. The secretary has contacted Attorney Corcoran and Bill Barnhart about this issue and both are reviewing it and seeking more information.

The secretary reported that we have received our liquid fuels disbursement of \$19,092.98.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the receipts and disbursements for April. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the treasurer's report for February. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Meeting adjourned at 7:45 PM.
