

April 14, 2008

James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther, Neal Maneval, and Tracy Plessinger; David Cunningham of Keller Engineers; Rick Gates, Rick Stackhouse, Ken Noel, and Jim Krause of GVMA, and Ryan Plessinger.

The minutes of the March regular meeting were read. Neal Maneval made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Visitors

Corporal Scholl, of the Ebensburg State Police Barracks, reported on the activity of the state police in White Township in recent months. He also answered questions from those present.

Public/Supervisor Comment

None.

Old Business

The secretary presented a final version of the proposed ordinance regulating on-lot sewage issues. The revisions of the SEO and solicitor have been incorporated. The supervisors will review the proposed ordinance for possible approval next month.

The new drainage pipes, which are a part of a PADEP strip mine reclamation project, have not yet been installed on Oshell Road.

The secretary reported that Keller Engineers have completed the weight and speed studies on township roads. Any weight or speed limits must be enacted by ordinance.

All funds from the former EIT collector's account have been distributed based on the calculations done by Central Tax Bureau. The account has been closed.

David Cunningham presented preliminary ideas for the new joint township/authority building and war memorial. There was a discussion involving the supervisors and the GVMA board members in attendance. The groups discussed possible size and location of the building and cost sharing options. David Cunningham also reported that Barb McMillen has agreed to provide a letter specifying the authority's share of the building as an allowable expense for the water/sewer project and the authority will be able to provide its share of funding for the building from the proceeds of the interim financing. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to proceed with plans for demolition of the existing building and design of the new building with the provisions that the approval letter from Barb McMillen be obtained and bids be acquired for salvageable items from the existing building. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

New Business/Secretaries Report

GVMA is ready to secure interim financing for the sewer portion of their project. As a part of that financing they will be requesting a loan guarantee from the township. The White Township share of the sewer financing is 26%. The supervisors were invited to attend the GVMA meeting on April 21. Jens Damgaard, Bill Barbin, and David Cunningham will all be at that meeting to answer the supervisor's questions. The Reade Township supervisors have also been invited to that meeting.

The CCBCEA has contacted Mr. Lang about his violation of the building code. He is cooperating on a resolution of the violation. It was also reported that Mr. Kramer, of St. Augustine Road, installed a trailer without proper inspections.

The secretary reported that we have been notified by the Cambria County Emergency Management Office that we need to appoint an Emergency Management Coordinator for the township. This appointment is necessary for the township or its residents to receive federal or state disaster relief funds. After discussion, it was determined that since the current EMC has not officially resigned, there would be no appointment made.

Coalport Borough is requesting a letter of support to obtain a grant for funding upgrades at the Coalport Park. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the request for a letter of support. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The state auditor general's office has completed an audit of liquid fuels funds for 2005 and 2006. No discrepancies were found, however, the state prefers that our liquid fuels funds be direct deposited rather than sending a check.

The spring convention of the CCATO will be held at the lemon drop on Friday, April 25.

If we are planning on a summer road project, we must approve it soon, so that it can go to bid.

The secretary reported that we have been notified by the Cambria County Emergency Management Agency that they will be renumbering the homes on Beaver Valley Road from the township line to Route 53 in Flinton. This is due to a conflict in 911 addresses for emergency responders.

We have received notification that our GIDA membership for 2008 is due. The dues have been included in this month's bills for payment.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve receipts and disbursements as presented. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the treasurer's report for March. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Meeting adjourned at 9:45 PM.
