Old Business

The secretary reported that New Enterprise will be doing our road project during the last week of August. They will contact the roadmaster before starting the job.

The secretary updated the supervisors on the status of the Glendale Yearound Sewage Treatment Plant relating to our Act 537 Plan. The PaDEP has sent a proposed consent decree. Both our engineer and solicitor have expressed concerns about the conclusions and recommendations of the proposed decree. Fred Soisson made a motion to send a letter to PaDEP declining to enter into the proposed consent decree. The response will include letters from our engineer and solicitor detailing their objections. Also the letter will offer two options for the resolution of the Yearound sewage situation. Either the Yearound system must be integrated into the municipal system or the township must be held harmless in all matters regarding the Yearound system. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

There was a discussion of needed office space and equipment for the township secretary. The matter was tabled until more information on costs is collected.

New Business/Secretaries Report

The secretary reported that Joann Farabaugh, real estate and per capita tax collector has submitted a letter of resignation. Fred Soisson made a motion of accept the Joann Farabaugh's resignation. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

A discussion followed concerning appointment of a new real estate and per capita tax collector. Fred Soisson made a motion to appoint Bonnie Plessinger as earned income and per capita tax collector to fill Joann Farabaugh's unexpired term. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Fred Soisson and James Luther voted aye. Tracy Plessinger abstained.
