James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther, Neal Maneval, and Tracy Plessinger, township solicitor Rich Corcoran, Don Yeagle, Kirk McCully, Mike Harpster, Steve Sinclair, and Bill Davis.

The minutes of the November regular meeting were read. Mr. Davis commented that he did not believe that the report given by the secretary constituted an update on the GVMA sewer/water project as it related to the possible purchase of the Glendale Yearound Sewer/Water Systems. The supervisors responded that the report gave all information that was available at the time. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

#### Public/Supervisor Comment

Mr. Davis questioned the supervisors and Mr. Corcoran about the ongoing negotiations for the possible purchase of the Glendale Yearound Sewer/Water Systems by the GVMA. He expressed his opinion that the purchase of the system is not in the best interest of Glendale Yearound residents and that the overall sewer/water project is not in the best interest of township residents in general.

Mr. Yeagle questioned the supervisors and Mr. Corcoran about the sewer and water projects in general and the mandatory tap ordinances specifically. He stated his opinion that his business would not be subject to the mandatory tap ordinance.

#### Old Business

The tentative budget has been approved and advertised as required. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the budget for 2006 as advertised. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The secretary updated the supervisors on the progress of the GVMA sewer/water project. Attorneys for White Township, GVMA, Glendale Yearound Sewer Company and PaDEP are working on a consent decree to allow the GVMA to purchase the Yearound system and eliminate the need for further litigation in this matter. Mr. Corcoran reported that the judge for the Environmental Hearing Board has set definite deadlines for the parties involved to reach an agreement or the township's appeals will proceed. When a tentative agreement is produced it will be presented to all parties for approval.

The secretary reported on the need for all supervisors to complete NIMS training. This training is available on the internet. All township officials must complete this training in order for the township to qualify for FEMA and PEMA disaster relief funds.

The secretary has checked on pricing to repair the flashing traffic signal in front of the township building. The cost to replace the bulbs would be approximately \$400. After discussion, it was decided that the roadmaster would contact a local electrician about doing the job.

#### New Business/Secretaries Report

There were six ordinances advertised relative to the sewer and water project. Mr. Corcoran explained the meaning and purpose for each ordinance. Mr. Maneval expressed his intention to abstain from voting on each of the ordinances due to his lack of familiarity with them.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the mandatory sewer connection ordinance and to authorize township officials to take all necessary actions to implement same. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Tracy Plessinger and James Luther voted aye. Neal Maneval abstained.

Lisa Helbig has resigned as the township's EIT collector. After discussion, it was determined that the township's only realistic alternative was to appoint Central Tax Bureau as our collection agent. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to appoint Central Tax Bureau as our EIT collector effective immediately and to authorize township officials to execute all necessary agreements to do so. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The secretary reported that the annual reorganization meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 3, 2006 at the township building. The change from Monday to Tuesday is due to the New Year Holiday falling on Monday in 2006.

#### Payment of Accounts

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve receipts and disbursements for December as presented. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

#### Treasurers Report

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the treasurer's report for November. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The secretary noted that new signature cards will be needed for all township accounts. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to place current supervisor's, James F. Luther, Neal E. Maneval, and Tracy A. Plessinger, names on all township accounts with two signatures required to transact business. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Meeting adjourned at 9:13 PM.
