James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's Prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther, Neal Maneval, and Tracy Plessinger.

The minutes of the November regular meeting were read. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Old Business

The secretary reported that we have not received any word from PennDOT yet on the traffic study on SR 1021.

The secretary is preparing an estimate of the cost of erecting the signage recommended by the engineering study that was done several years ago on all township roads to establish speed and weight limits. This estimate will also include new street signs to meet the new federal standards for signage. All of these costs are eligible to be paid from liquid fuels funds.

The secretary reported that we have not installed delineators on the driveway or culverts yet. The road master recommended that we order the tool necessary for installation from US Municipal Supply.

The state park is ready to move forward with installation of the Snowmobile Crossing signs which were previously approved by the board. The secretary has ordered these from US Municipal Supply. The township will bill the state park for the signs when we receive an invoice.

No decision has been made yet on the township sharing the cost of secretarial staff.

The secretary reported that the Cambria County Healthcare Consortium is changing insurance carriers to UPMC. Quotes have been obtained to purchase UPMC insurance from Kessler Benefits Group in Johnstown. The cost is substantially lower than the same insurance through the consortium. UPMC will allow the township and GVMA to combine employees to create a group. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to leave the Cambria County Healthcare Consortium and join the GVMA in a group to purchase UPMC Medical Insurance through Kessler Benefits Group. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

New Business/Secretaries Report

The secretary presented a tentative budget for 2011. The tentative budget projects revenues of \$178,250 and expenses of \$154,000. Proposed tax rates are; Real Estate Tax – 1.5 mils; Local Services Tax - \$5.00; Real Estate Transfer Tax - 0.5%; Earned Income Tax – 0.5%. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the tentative budget as presented and advertise as required. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve receipts for and disbursements for December. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the treasurer's report for November. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Meeting adjourned at 8:20 PM.
