James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther, Neal Maneval, and Tracy Plessinger, Charlie Locky, Bill Davis, and Tom Dedeo.

The minutes of the January regular meeting were distributed to all supervisors prior to the meeting. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes and approve the minutes as presented. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

#### Visitors

Charlie Locky asked about the status of any junk car or junk yard ordinances. The supervisors explained that they were not prepared at this time to take any action on such an ordinance but would continue to investigate and review ordinances and actions of other townships in the area.

#### Old Business

The secretary presented an audit of the township's previous EIT collector's account. All funds deposited were found to be in the account, however the records were in disarray and further investigation will be required to determine how those funds should be dispersed. This investigation work will be carried out by Central Tax Bureau, which has been appointed as the township's new EIT collector. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to accept the audit report from Johnston, Nelson & Shimmel. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

#### New Business/Secretaries Report

The CCSEA has developed a new policy for handling complaints. Anonymous complaints will be referred to the township supervisors for initial inspection to determine if there is sufficient cause for the SEO to investigate further. The SEO will then proceed based on the supervisor's findings and recommendations.

The Glendale Yearound POA has requested that they receive special notification about special meetings and hearings of the board of supervisors. After discussion, the board of supervisors determined that the proper legal notification of meeting is sufficient. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to notify the Glendale Yearound POA that the board of supervisors will not make special notification to it about meetings and hearings. Jim Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The township has received application for membership in the GIDA for the coming year. The membership dues are included in the bills for payment.

Peggy Ansley has submitted a letter of resignation as Assistant Emergency Management Coordinator. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to accept the Peggy Ansley's letter of resignation as Assistant Emergency Management Coordinator. Jim Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The township has received an application to renew our membership in the CCATO. The membership dues are included in the bills for payment.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the receipts and disbursements for February. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the treasurer's report for January. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Meeting adjourned at 8:32 PM.
