

James Luther, chairman, called the reorganization and regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther, Neal Maneval, and Tracy Plessinger.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to appoint James Luther as temporary chairman and Tracy Plessinger as temporary secretary. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to appoint the following officers for 2010. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to establish the regular monthly meetings for 2011 on the second Monday of each month at 7:00 PM prevailing time. Meetings will be held at the township building in Beaver Valley. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to establish the following tax rates for 2011. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

- Real Estate – 1.5 mills
- Local Services Tax - \$5.00
- Earned Income and Net Profit Tax - ½ of 1%
- Realty Transfer Tax - ½ of 1%

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to recommend to the Board of Auditors the establishment of the following supervisor salaries for 2010. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

- Road Master - \$100.00/month up to 10 hours - \$11.00/hour for hours over 10
- Road Foreman - \$11.00/hour
- Labor – \$10.00/hour
- Secretary/Treasurer
  - Salary - \$37,838/year – (\$9,838 township share). Scheduled to raise to \$43,243/year (\$11,243 township share) when Notice to Proceed is issued for GVMA project.
  - Benefits - Health Insurance - \$9,356.16/year (\$2,432.60 township share).
- Pick-up truck - \$9.00/hour
- Mileage – Prevailing IRS allowance. (Currently \$0.50/mile)

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to establish the following salaries for employees for 2011. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

- Custodian - \$9.00/hour, \$11.00/hour when using own equipment.
- Real Estate/PerCapita Tax Collector – 5% commission
- EIT/LST Collector – Rate established by contract with Centax

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to establish the Treasurer's Bond at \$500,000 for 2011. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to allow township officials and employees to attend training seminars at the township's expense in 2011. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

#### Regular January Meeting

The minutes of the December meeting were read. Neal Maneval made a motion to approve the December minutes as presented. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

#### Old Business

The secretary reported that there were no auditors elected in the November election. This leaves two vacancies on the township auditor's board. We have received a quote from Kotzan Associates to do the audit. They would charge \$3,000. After discussion, it was decided that we will continue to use local elected auditors to do the annual audit. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to appoint Carol Keifer and Betty Barnhart to serve as auditors until the next municipal election in 2011. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

#### New Business/Secretary's report

The secretary suggested that we hold a joint workshop meeting with Reade and Chest Townships to review the past, present, and future of the GVMA water and sewer projects. It would also be an opportunity to discuss other issues of common interest. Both Reade and Chest have suggested January 18 as a possible meeting date. After discussion the date was agreed to. The secretary will send a reminder and information to the supervisors of all three townships.

#### Payment of Accounts

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve disbursements in the amount of \$2,373.12 for January. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the treasurer's report for December 31, 2009. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.
