James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther, Neal Maneval, and Tracy Plessinger; David Cunningham, Keller Engineers; Ernie Potuschnig, Kirk McCully, Don Yeagle, Pam Krug, Fern Krug, Bill Davis, and Peggy Ansley.

The minutes of the June regular meeting were read. Neal Maneval made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Visitors

None.

Public/Supervisor Comment

Ernie Potuschnig and Peggy Ansley addressed the board about the addressed the board about the problem with coal trucks speeding on Church Hill Road. The trucks are under contract to E.P. Bender Coal Company. The trucks are also using their "jake brakes" when they are traveling empty up hill, apparently as a way to intentionally antagonize the residents that live along Church Hill Road. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to send letters to E.P. Bender Coal Company, Penn DOT, and the PA State Police regarding the problem. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Old Business

David Cunningham updated the supervisors on the progress of the new building. Work has reached the stage of essential completion. There is one more change order to be approved for work done in the final phases of the building completion. Payment of this change order and application will be held until all final items are completed. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve change order #2 in the amount of \$10,690.00. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The township has received a letter from our solicitor regarding the question of sludge application. In our solicitor's opinion, townships are not permitted to prohibit or otherwise regulate the spreading of sludge in their boundaries. The only exception to this is that townships may limit the location of sludge application through the use of zoning. However, since White Township does not have a zoning ordinance, this is not an option for us.

The secretary updated the supervisors on the status of the Jack Bowling sewage complaint. Our solicitor has advised two possible resolutions. The matter could be filed as a criminal complaint at the office of the Magisterial District Judge or it could be filed as a civil action in Cambria County Court. Our solicitor recommends the civil action as a more speedy and enforceable solution. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to instruct Attorney Barbin to file the necessary action in Cambria County Court. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

New Business/Secretaries Report

Two ordinances proposed by the CCBCEA have been advertised for approval. These ordinances have been prepared by the agency's solicitor, Bill Barbin, who is also the township's solicitor.

An ordinance holding contractors liable for not acquiring proper permits. (Ordinance #2009-1)

An ordinance of intermunicipal cooperation allowing CCBCEA to enforce zoning, property maintenance and other local ordinances as directed by the Board of Supervisors. (Ordinance #2009-2)

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve both ordinances as presented. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The secretary reported that Patton Borough is holding a meeting regarding the possibility of establishing a regional police force in northern Cambria County. The supervisors did not express an interest in White Township participating at this point in time.
