

James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther , Fred Soisson, and Tracy Plessinger, and Joe and Anna Mary Reynolds. Bill Barhart arrived at 7:30 PM and Rick Gates arrived at 8:00 PM.

The minutes of the February regular meeting were read. Fred Soisson made a motion to approve the minutes. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Old Business

The secretary reported that members of the board of the CCSEA will be meeting again with county commissioners about the problems townships are having enforcing subdivision regulations.

The secretary presented a letter to be sent to Attorney Govachini concerning his practice of billing us for sending us letters updating us on various state regulations. The letter informs Attorney Govachini that we will no longer pay for these services. Fred Soisson made a motion to send Attorney Govachini send the letter as presented. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

New Business/Secretaries Report

The supervisors welcomed Dr. Fred Soisson to the Board of Supervisors. He will be filling the remainder of Peggy Ansley's term.

We have applied for a 50% reimbursement from DEP of our membership fee to join the CCSEA.

After consulting with Larry Custer of the Cambria County Redevelopment Authority, it has been determined that in order to receive a state grant for start-up costs for the Cambria County Building Codes Enforcement Agency we will need to provide matching local monies. Each township is being asked to pay a \$700 membership fee to provide these needed funds. A motion was made by Tracy Plessinger to approve the resolution of intent to join the Cambria County Building Codes Enforcement Agency and to allocate \$700 to the Agency for start-up costs. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye. (A copy of the resolution is attached to these minutes.)

A complaint has been filed with the PA State Attorney General's office concerning our EIT collector. The individual filing the complaint is due a refund that they have not received. Our EIT collector has been unable to send the refund because we have not received the taxes in question from Bradford Township in Clearfield County. Our EIT collector and the secretary have both responded to the complaint and explained the situation to the Attorney General's office.

The secretary presented a letter of resignation from Kathy Barquist, EIT collector, effective April 12, 2004. Fred Soisson made a motion to accept, with regret, Kathy Barquist's resignation and to advertise for a new EIT/OPT collector. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The secretary presented information about various training opportunities. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to allow any township official to attend training opportunities throughout the year. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Bill Barnhart of the Glendale Yearound presented a proposed change to the Yearound subdivision. Tracy Plessinger questioned whether the supervisors should approve revisions that will make it easier to sell properties in the Yearound development when they have no approved plan for expansion of their sewage treatment plant. A discussion followed concerning this issue. Fred Soisson made a motion to approve the proposed subdivision revision. Jim Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Fred Soisson and Jim Luther voted aye. Tracy Plessinger voted nay.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to pay the following bills and to authorize the secretary to pay any additional bills necessary to make all accounts current for the end of the year. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.
