The secretary reported that he is still working to finalize the proposed ordinance regulating on-lot sewage issues, adding the SEO's revisions. A finalized version should be ready for next month's meeting.

The roadmaster reported that PADEP has expanded its strip mine reclamation project at the end of Frye Road. This will cause a delay in the installation of new drainage pipes under Oshell Road, which PADEP is replacing as a part of that project.

The secretary reported that Keller Engineers will be doing the weight and speed limit studies on township roads as the weather allows.

New Business/Secretaries Report

David Cunningham reported on the possibility of constructing a building to be shared by the township and the GVMA. He presented some preliminary sketches of a building and war memorial and how to integrate those two projects together. The building would be owned by the township, but shared with the authority. There was discussion regarding costs of a new building, how it could be funded, whether or not the existing building should be demolished, and the best way to integrate the proposed war memorial into the new building project. If we decide to move forward with a project, David and Adam Long will attend next month's meeting to provide further detail regarding all of the issues discussed. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to agree in principle to sharing construction costs and use of a building with the GVMA providing that details agreeable to both entities can be worked out. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye. Neal Maneval made a motion to write a letter to the Penns Woods District of the Boy Scouts of America explaining the situation with the war memorial and asking that Ryan Plessinger be given credit toward his Eagle badge for having progressed the project to this point. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve receipts and disbursements presented for March. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the treasurer's report for February. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.
