James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther, Neal Maneval, and Tracy Plessinger; David Cunningham of Keller Engineers; Peggy Ansley, Diane Gorman, and John Gorman.

The minutes of the April regular meeting were read. Neal Maneval made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Visitors

Peggy Ansley addressed the board with concerns regarding health issues relating to the spreading of municipal sludge in White Township. There is currently a plan in development to spread sludge in Beccaria Township. Ms. Ansley presented information obtained on the internet regarding sludge application and a sample ordinance to prohibit sludge application in White Township, which she requested that the township approve. The supervisors will review the information and take Ms. Ansley's concerns under advisement. At present the supervisors are not aware of any plans in development to spread sludge in White Township.

Public/Supervisor Comment

Old Business

The bids were opened for the advertised summer road project. The following bids were received:

New Enterprise Stone and Lime Company, Inc. - \$19,117.50 (\$1.25/sq.yd.)

Grannas Brothers Stone and Asphalt Company, Inc. - \$22,023.36 (\$1.44/sq.yd.)

HRI, Inc. - \$21,717.48 (\$1.42/sq.yd.)

James Luther made a motion to accept the bid from New Enterprise Stone and Lime Company, Inc. in the amount of \$19,117.50 and to authorize township officials and personnel to execute all related documents and take all related actions. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

David Cunningham updated the supervisors on construction of the new township/GVMA building. The interior finishing is progressing according to schedule but the landscaping around the building is being delayed by the wet weather. Work will progress as the weather allows. There was a discussion about the drainage ditch on township property and its access to the PennDOT ditch along Beaver Valley Road. The road master will check with PennDOT about cleaning the ditch and the secretary will check with the Glendale Fire Company about flushing the pipe under Baker Lane.

Dave Cunningham presented a change order from McCloskey Builders to approve changes made to the building contract involving the underground oil tank, heat pump, upgrade of doors and an allowance for not replacing the incorrect colored pillars. The change orders total a \$12,695 increase in the original contract. Neal Maneval made a motion to approve the change orders. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

New Business/Secretaries Report

Chest Township has approved the Act 537 amendment to eliminate the Glendale Yearound Sewage Treatment plant and route the sewage flows from the Yearound to the new GVMA treatment plant in Flinton. Although White Township had approved the plan in the past, Dave Cunningham recommends that we vote again to take into account minor changes that were made since our last vote. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the Act 537 amendment as presented. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The GVMA has advertised for its manager position. Applications have been received and a joint executive session needs to be scheduled with GVMA to review the applications.
