James Luther, chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the White Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:00 PM. The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States of America and the Lord's Prayer.

Those present included supervisors James Luther, Neal Maneval, and Tracy Plessinger.

The minutes of the October regular meeting were read. James Luther made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Old Business

The secretary reported that we have not received any word from PennDOT yet on the traffic study on SR 1021.

The secretary is preparing an estimate of the cost of erecting the signage recommended by the engineering study that was done several years ago on all township roads to establish speed and weight limits. This estimate will also include new street signs to meet the new federal standards for signage. All of these costs are eligible to be paid from liquid fuels funds.

New Business/Secretaries Report

There was a discussion regarding the installation of delineators on the lane entrance to the township building and also at culverts on township roads. The secretary has contacted Larry Noel, of Appalachian Innovations, about doing the installation and he is interested. The road master will check on an installation tool to do the work.

The secretary reported that the GVMA is going to be hiring a full time administrative assistant. There is also a possibility that they may hire a part time administrative assistant to help with billing. The secretary requested that the supervisors consider participating in some way to allow the township to have some extra clerical help. After discussion, it was determined that the supervisors would have an interest in hiring a part time administrative assistant that could be share responsibilities with the GVMA.

There was a discussion regarding winter road maintenance. Slovikosky Excavating is currently in the second year of a three year contract to maintain all roads on the west side of the township at a flat rate of \$7,980/season. The PennDOT rate for winter maintenance for the 2010-2011 season is \$1425.62/lane mile. Tracy Plessinger made a motion of contract with Reade Township to maintain Foster Road at a cost of \$1,710.74 (\$1,425.62 x 2 lanes x .6 miles) and with Clearfield Township to maintain Gates Road at a cost of \$1,710.74 (\$1,425.62 x 2 lanes x .6 miles). Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve receipts for and disbursements for November. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the treasurer's report for October. Neal Maneval seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.
