Those present included supervisors James Luther, Fred Soisson, and Tracy Plessinger, Nancy Long, and Joan Gearhart. Bill Barnhart arrived at 7:24 pm.

The minutes of the August regular meeting were read. Fred Soisson made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. James Luther seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Public/Supervisor Comment

Nancy Long and Joan Gearhart asked about the per capita tax. The secretary explained that we have been researching the per capita tax with the county and school district. We will be working to update the per capita tax roles before next years mailing. Also, all citizens aged 72 or older are exempt from the per capita tax. The school district business manager will be forwarding the appropriate exemption forms to the per capita tax collector.

Bill Barnhart presented a proposed change to the Glendale Yearound Subdivision Plan. He noted that the proposed change will not affect flows to the Glendale Yearound Sewage Treatment Plant. Fred Soisson made a motion to approve the proposed changes. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

Old Business

New Enterprise has requested an extension till next spring for our road project. Fred Soisson made a motion to grant the extension for the road project. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The proposed amendment to our Act 537 Plan has been properly advertised. No public comment has been received. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to approve the proposed amendment to our Act 537 plan including the Glendale Yearound system in the municipal system. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

There was a discussion of needed office space and equipment for the township secretary. The matter was tabled until more information on costs is collected.

New Business/Secretaries Report

The secretary presented the minutes and agenda from the October meetings of the CCSEA and CCBCEA.

The township has received a proposed updated Emergency Operations Plan from the county. Fred Soisson made a motion to approve the resolutions implementing and promulgating the Emergency Operations Plan. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye. A copy of the resolution is attached to the minutes.

The township has received a proposed Hazard Mitigation Plan from the county. Fred Soisson made a motion to approve the resolution enacting the proposed Hazard Mitigation Plan. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye. A copy of the resolution is attached to the minutes.

The secretary explained the expenses incurred by the property tax collector in connection with collection of said taxes. Tracy Plessinger made a motion that the township reimburse the tax collector for 1/3 of costs involved with tax collection including phone bill. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The secretary explained the need for an ordinance to collect a fee for tax certification and no lien letters. These fees must be enacted by ordinance. Fred Soisson made a motion to enact an ordinance for collection fees for various township services and to have the solicitor prepare and advertise such and ordinance. Tracy Plessinger seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.

The secretary reported that in order for the tax collector to update real estate and per capita tax records the township must pass a motion authorizing her to do so. Tracy Plessinger made a motion to authorize the real estate/per capita tax collector to update real estate and per capita tax records. Fred Soisson seconded the motion. A vote was taken. All three supervisors voted aye.
